

The routines in this book are pretty realistic, and the girls' concerns and triumphs are clearly shown - seems like it'd be pretty encouraging to any girl taking gymnastics.

This was for my 8 year old granddaughter, it was more like a nursery book and it wasn't really even a book. Very disappointed. Would not recommend for any child the age of those in the cover photo. Not sure who it would be good for.

I bought this book for my 6 year old budding gymnast and she really enjoyed it. She could read it by herself and the "workout" described in the book was really similar to the workout she receives at her gymnastics class. I would recommend this book.

Another great book to that I read with my aspiring gymnast daughter. It is a great way to tie gymnastics in with progressing reading skills. I can also see it as a good book to get for a child who may want to be in gymnastics.

My seven year old daughter is a promising little gymnast. This book is easier to read than she is capable of, but she still enjoys reading it over and over. She loves that the illustrations show realistic moves done well. I like the fact that it prominantly shows an African American character. It isn't easy to find gymnastics related things with "Brown" (as she calls herself) people in them.

Good book for any children who are taking gymnastics classes or are interested in gymnastics. Easy to read for children that are still learning to read but want to read books on their own.

My 3 1/2 year old daughter enjoyed the information in this book. On each page she would try to do whatever the girls were doing (she's in a preschool tumbling class and learning these things there too.) It doesn't really explain the steps of learning any of the items, but it does give pointers like always keeping toes pointed.

I bought this as a christmas gift for my 7 year old niece. It's a cute book but for a younger girl. She still liked her gift thank goodness.!
