

I bought 4 of these My Weird School Daze books. This was the first and LAST one we will read!

Both my husband and I were appalled at the crude way these kids talk. We don't use the words

"stupid" or "hate" in our family. I wasn't thrilled with the "butt" references either.. I won't even donate these to the library! Ugh!

My daughter loves this series of book and even though she can plow through one of them in a day it is still a book that distracts her from TV, computer or video games. That is a plus in todays society. The content is decent for late second graders but I always would advise a parent to skim a book before handing it over to their child to read.

My son is 8 and in the 3rd grade and has been rather reluctant to read chapter books, but this one was so FUNNY it had me laughing too! I think I am pretty picky about the "potty" humor boy books, but I thought this one compared to Captain Underpants or Diary of a Wimpy Kid was much cleaner and cuter. I loved the one character(Arlo), because he sounds a lot like my son...forgetful, complaining and not into girls! If your kid needs a good laugh and a book they can relate too then I would try it out from the library first if you are worried, but we will be getting more of these...if I can laugh along it makes it so much more fun! Sometimes you have to loosen up the reigns. Kids will hear all those words it is how you teach them to use or not use them that matters.

My son loves this series of books. He is just starting to read chapter books. These books are not too lengthy to loose his interest, but after reading each one he has a sense of accomplishment. He finds them funny and usually finishes one a day.
