I had an android delivered yesterday and so far I've been 'playing' with it for around 8 hours. Becoming frustrated I decided to buy this book thinking it would help me. There was nothing in the book about how to manage the various screens; nothing about how to log in to an E-mail and nothing about how to 'delete' items. On Windows there is a little red square with which to delete - this does not exist on androids. There must be another way. I'd like to know what it is. I would have preferred him to spend more space on how to get rid of symbols and arranging the screen for the adult user.

But I really don't think so because so much of the content is so similar to information and advice provided to new Kindle owners.
