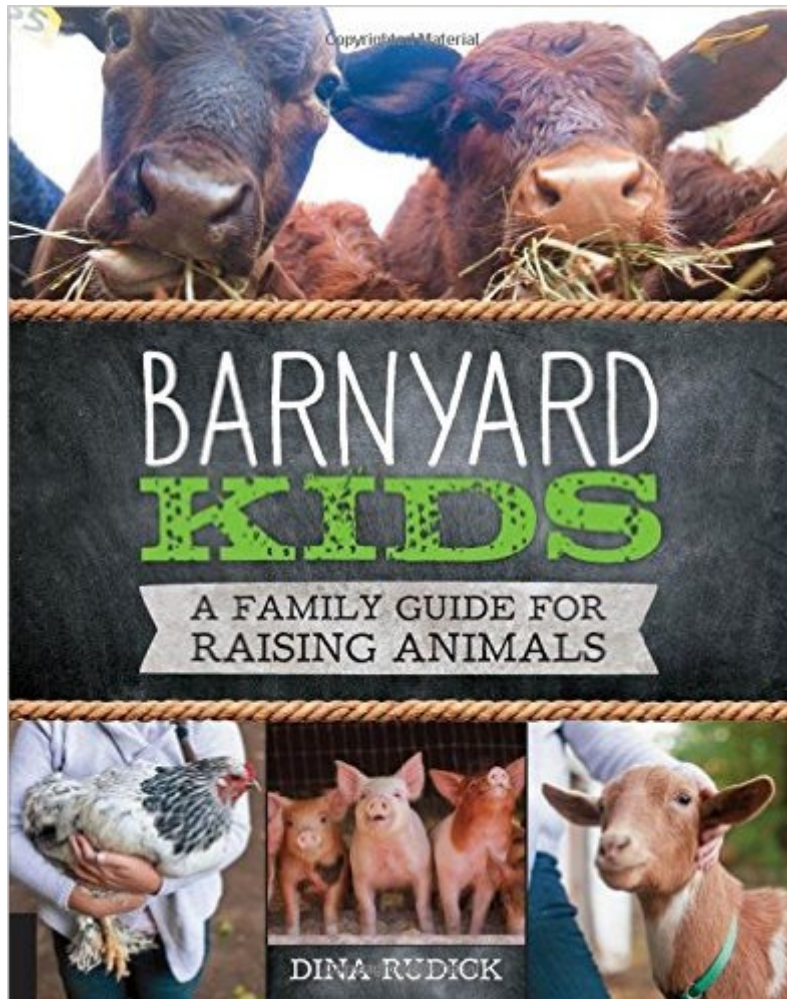

This numbered one hundred and sixty page oversized paperback targets families with children considering raising animals on their properties. With no extremely scary or awkward scenes, the book focuses on six animals that can live in a homestead environment. Spread throughout the book, Wellsâ s illustrations are in full color and easy to decipher. Photographs cover from one-eighth of a page to the entire page. After a dedication to her toddler son,

introduction, and a foreword by Ben Holmes, the five chapters cover chickens, pigs, sheep and goats, cows, horses, and rabbits. The end of the book contains resources, author's biography, acknowledgments, and an extensive index. Each chapter has discussions on what makes the animal tick with pictures and diagrams, things that make them sick, where they live, what they can give, a question and answer section, and routine schedule. The information is concise and to the point with many tips, suggestions, and instructions on important things to know. Some of the interesting facts given include the following quotes: "An egg's shell has more than 6,000 tiny holes or pores in it that let the egg breathe. Hot weather is more dangerous for pigs than cold weather. Goats are picky eaters and won't eat anything that has fallen on the ground."
