The Walking Dead is a stellar series written by Robert Kirkman. At first glance, it looks like a zombie gore comic. Once you actually read it, you can discover it is much more than that. This 3rd Omnibus is Oversized and features a gorgeous cover (Not dust cover). It collects issues 49-72. Even though the interior art is black and white, it is detailed & works very well. The fact that it is in oversize only adds too Adlard's excellent art. The full color covers are featured in the back, something you can't find in the trade paperbacks. This omnibus collects 4 TPB's, which is four storylines. In this omnibus you'll read about how the Survivors recover from their recent losses and attempt to reach Washington D.C. Overall, I give this a 5/5.

These are gorgeous collections. They are indeed heavy and a little on the large size, which makes for a little more difficult reading in bed, but if you're a collector/big fan of the series, these are a must have. Additional sketches, drawings, and "making of" pages in the back are worth it on their own.

If you like the series, you will love the books. As most know, the show is based on these graphic novels. Most of the story lines follow pretty close to it as well. I will say there is just enough difference that I want to both watch and read the comic side by side. The comic is much darker than the TV show and there is cursing. Most I have talked to enjoy the comic just as much as the TV Show. Def worth a read!

I own the first two Walking Dead omnibuses, and this one does the same. The story is incredible (much better than the television show IMO), and it is cool to see how the show has utilized the comics as a skeletal outline for their writing. If you are a fan of the shows, you should check out it's source material because while they are similar there are some major distinctions. All in all, it is a nice way to round out the Walking Dead universe experience.

After watching the tv series, I didn't know if I would enjoy the comic book series. How wrong I was. The story is similar in some aspects and totally different in others. Highly recommend this to anyone interested in the walking dead. I'm taking my time with these because I want to savor every detailed drawing and experience it in all it's glory. A++ it's a must buy folks.

I am very grateful that these omnibus volumes are available. They are a great way to get caught up on the history of the story and to see the differences between the illustrated story vs the cable show on AMC.
