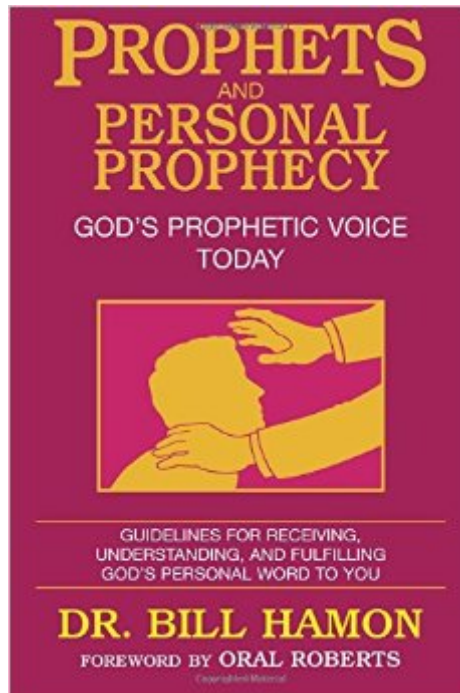

I have read this book over and over again. Every time I read it, I notice gold nuggets I overlooked before. One thing the Lord made stand out in my spirit while reading this book was that I really have to walk in his love and learn more about it in order to operate effectively in any ministry. The Word does say that if we prophecy, prophecy will cease if we have not love. The Word says that without love, none of the other gifts mean anything. If we don't love those around us the way the Lord would, what makes us think we would be set loose on his church. It has answered so many questions about prophets and personal prophecy that I couldn't get anywhere else. Though we all have pastors, teachers, etc., they are human as well and aren't always available or easy to get time with. It was wonderful to find a book to feed my hungry heart without having to arrange to talk to someone else. I couldn't stop reading and the more I read, the hungrier I became...sort of like a starving child sitting down to his/her first meal after a week with no food. Dr. Hamon's first volume is essential for anyone involved in charismatic and prophetic issues within the Christian community. It will spare the reader many potential disasters if the precepts contained are practiced. He removes the spookiness, fraud, mystique and hyper-spirituality often associated with charismatic gifts, particularly prophecy.

Bill Hammon is a mature prophet of today. Unlike many he has avoided the pitfalls of money and power that have caused others to fall. Here he writes what he has learned about God speaking to us today, of God providing us with direction and of encouragement that is directly from Him. And he provides us with guidelines on how to validate what we hear from God and how to interpret timing from one who deals with eternity not time. There is a sequel, Prophets, Pitfalls and Prophecies.

Dr. Hamon has hit the nail on the head once again. He has saved us countless hours of pain and heartache by sharing his prophetic experiences and lessons with us in this book. Prophecy and the Office of Prophet are essential to the success and the growth of the Body of Christ. Dr. Hamon has removed the mystery surrounding this office and gift.

Bill Hamon is a forerunner in the prophetic ministry today and his journey with full time ministry began at age 19. Since then he has pastored, taught, developed schools of theology, the Holy Spirit, and a school of the Prophets. With 4 decades that have passed he has laid hands on and personally prophesied over more than 15,000 people. He shares this book in knowing that today God's will for the church to function optimally is for the five-fold ministry to be in place with the

apostles and prophets functioning as God's design. The prophetic ministry spoken of in this book is to reveal the mind of Christ and give instructions to individuals concerning His will for their lives. You will gain an understanding of the Rhema vs Logos word and how God applies each to our lives. How vital it is that the rhema word is spoken over a situation while prophesying to others and there are guidelines offered for determining whether a thought is a true rhema from the Lord. The testimonies you will read will build your faith in the validity and important role they play in guiding others into the will of God. Other vital areas that will be addressed include the following: *5 channels of prophecy* Important information regarding marriage and romance prophecies *Pitfalls to ignoring the prompting from the Holy Spirit* Characteristics of personal prophecy and how to respond properly *Hinderances to the fulfillment of personal prophecy. I consider this book to be very thorough in understanding the role of prophets and how personal prophecy operates. This book is highly recommended for individuals, church libraries, and ministers regardless of the area within which they work.
