

Not only is the engraving large and easy to read - the binding allows the book to stay open on a music stand all by itself! Each song is in the key of C and uses the five basic chords (major, minor, seventh, augmented, and diminished.) So here you have the lyrics and melodies for over 100 classics - 'My Sweet Lord' by George Harrison, 'Still the Same' by Bob Seger, 'How Deep Is Your Love' by the Bee Gees, 'If' by Bread, and the list goes on.

If you remembered the seventies, you will be thrilled with the selection of music you will easily be able to play. These books are the greatest thing since sliced bread if you ask me. I took endless piano lessons as a child, and eventually wound up as many youngsters do, being dragged kicking and screaming to my lessons. What "kid" wants to learn how to play little bits of Mozart, Bach and Beethoven? NO, they want to learn how to play things they can relate to, and many of the songs

contained in the fake book will be familiar to even the youngest learner as they have never left the radio waves over the decades. Had this been available for me when I was younger, I would have been thrilled to continue my lessons. If you can read music, you can play right out of the book upon arrival, if not, you can purchase key stickers to help you get started. These books are wonderful because they have also included a teaching chord chart in the back. You can take it out if you like, and have it on the piano next to the music in order to familiarize yourself with chords you may not remember or know. This is a great way to entertain yourself or even your friends.
